Concentrations

Leverage your psychology degree in the marketplace by pinpointing your area of study. Customize your program by selecting your preferred concentration:

HEALTH PSYCHOLOGY

Students complete 16 credits specific to Health Psychology. Gain the theoretical background of how psychological, behavioral, cultural, and social factors influence health and wellness. Plus, examine stress and pain interventions as well as the role of stress and lifestyle choices and how they affect our well-being.

MARRIAGE AND FAMILY

Students complete 16 credits specific to Marriage and Family. Examine foundations for family communication, problem solving, and relationships; a systems perspective on family dynamics and their impact upon marital quality and the family; as well as counseling and intervention strategies.

GENERAL (NO CONCENTRATION DECLARED)

Students complete 16 credits in related coursework. (A transfer friendly option for students who have completed coursework related to their degree).
