

Internship/Practicum Registration Steps

Unlike other courses, students must manually register for an internship/practicum so that the appropriate parties can sign off on the experience prior to registration. Students use Handshake instead of theRock to complete this process. On Handshake, internships and practicums are referred to as "Experiences".

- 1. View the back of this handout for your major's requirements and prerequisites.
- Meet with your faculty internship supervisor to determine whether your internship fits your major/minor's requirements. Note: Your faculty internship supervisor may be different than your academic advisor.
- □ To determine your faculty internship supervisor:

Log-in to theRock

Choose the Academics Tab

Click "Browse Classes"

Select the correct term

Enter your course code (see back of this handout or the course catalog)

- **Please note—for Biology and Health Sciences students your academic advisor will also serve as your faculty internship supervisor
- ☐ Email the professor assigned to that course code to set-up a face-to-face or phone meeting.
- 3. After you have received & accepted an internship offer:
- □ Complete the internship registration form on Handshake:
 - 1. Log-in to theRock
 - 2. Go to the "Career Development" tab
 - 3. Click the Handshake logo to log-in
 - 4. Hover your mouse over "Career Center" and select "Experiences"
 - 5. Choose "Request an Experience"
 - 6. Complete and submit the form

Your internship/practicum will then be reviewed by Career Development and our staff will have it approved by your faculty internship supervisor, the Registrar's office, and your on-site supervisor. You will receive an email from the Registrar once you are registered for academic credit.
